

## **Minutes of Stamford Bridge Parish Council meeting held on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> May 2017 at 7.30 pm in the back room of the Village Hall.**

6. To discuss matters arising from previous Minutes:

6.1 Update from Councillor Bragg on the Agenda for the 2017 Parish AGM.

Councillor Bragg confirmed that Rosti and Derwent Lions would be attending along with Stamford Bridge Football club, Stamford Bridge PFA, Guides, the Swimming pool and Village Hall.

He said posters were now out, photographs to be shown had been organised and he was just hoping for a good turn-out.

6.2 Update from Councillor R Clarke on grant applications from Stamford Bridge Summer Fair, Swimming pool, and the Village Hall.

To agree a grant for the Village Hall as recommended by the Finance Committee

Councillor R Clarke updated the meeting on the finance committee meeting recommendations.

- 1) It was agreed that the Village Hall could have a grant of £1000.00, for the toilet alterations and refurbishment provided work started before March 2018.

Councillor Flynn proposed the grant of £1000 to the village hall. This was seconded by Councillor Bragg with all Councillors in favour.

- 2) The swimming pool was awarded £1000.00, as an emergency fund which would be on call down as required during 2017/18 to help pay for urgent maintenance problems (breakages etc.).

Councillor Butterfield proposed the draw down grant of £1000 to the Swimming Pool. This was seconded by Councillor Flynn with all Councillors in favour.

The grant of £500.00 for the Summer Fair had already been agreed at a previous Parish Council meeting but had been held up awaiting banking details which had now being provided.

Councillor Flynn proposed the grant of £500.00 to the Summer Fair. This was seconded by Councillor Rutherford with all Councillors in favour.

6.3 Councillor C Clarke to provide update on the Information Centre feasibility Study.

Councillor C Clarke confirmed that a meeting had now being arranged with ERYC to discuss an Information Centre and it was hoped that a feasibility study would be able to take place following the meeting.  
Councillor C Clarke to report back to the June meeting.

6.4 To receive a report from Councillor Bragg following his attendance at the East Riding of Yorkshire Community Transport Strategy 2016-2020 Launch Event held on the 24<sup>th</sup> March.

Councillor Bragg has attended the East Riding of Yorkshire Community Transport Strategy 2016-2020 Launch, but it was aimed mainly at very rural areas with no Public Bus facility and therefore excluded Stamford Bridge.

6.5 Update on the proposed extension of the 40mph speed limit on A166 Roman Road, as part of the planning agreement for the new housing development by ERYC.

The Councillor Kealey reported that he had been sent a copy of an e-mail that Ward Councillor Strangeway had received from ERYC stating the reasons why they could not extend both 30 and 40 mph limits further than had been agreed

*“ERYC can only consider 30mph speed limits on the outskirts of towns and villages where there is enough roadside properties for drivers to see the requirement to slow down. The new housing developments off the A166 will have two new accesses and the road has been locally widened to accommodate ghost islands (short right turn lanes). The widened road, provision for right turns and all of the new houses being set back from the road mean drivers will see no need to slow down.”*

The Parish Council had already written to ERYC and stated the need for this speed reduction. It was agreed that the Parish Council would look again at the scheme once it is completed.

6.6 Councillor C Clarke to update the Councillors on a proposed footpath from Saxon Gate (new housing site) to Full Sutton.

Councillor C Clarke reported that he is looking to get letters of support from Rambling Clubs etc to get a proposed footpath to Full Sutton, which will also require permission to join up two existing Parish Footpaths.

6.7 Update from Councillor Shuttleworth on the replacement bus stop equipment from ERYC

Moved to the June meeting as Councillor Shuttleworth was unable to attend the meeting.

7. To report and make relevant recommendations on new planning applications and subsequent plans received after the Agenda is sent out:

7.1. Village Hall 4 Low Catton Road - TPO DERWENT HILL, STAMFORD BRIDGE - 1977 (REF: 329) A2: Sweet chestnut; topped off and crown lifted to 2-8m along with dead wood. Beech; Brace, Beech: crown lift to 7-8m to clear scout hut roof and prevent overhanging into neighbouring properties. Oak: crown lift to 7-8m to clear scout hut roof and prevent overhanging into neighbouring properties.

7.2 10 The Square - Display of 3 non-illuminated fascia signs to front
