NEW PRISON DEVELOPMENT – PUBLIC PREVIEW OF REVISED PROPOSALS

We are writing to let you know that the Ministry of Justice (MoJ) will soon be applying for planning permission to build a new prison on land adjacent to HM Prison Full Sutton. Following the last public engagement events in April 2017, at which we shared our plans for the new prison, we have been developing our plans in more detail and we're now at the stage where we would like to share our revised proposals with local residents.

It is important to us that local residents have the opportunity to view the updated plans, which is why we've arranged a public preview event which will take place over two days as follows:

- **Tuesday 20th November between 15:00 and 20:00** at the HMP Full Sutton Training Centre, off Moor Lane, Full Sutton, YO41 1PS; and
- **Wednesday 21st November between 15:00 and 20:00** at Stamford Bridge Methodist Church Hall, The Square, Stamford Bridge, YO141 1AG

At the event, representatives from the MoJ will be on hand to answer any questions and to go into greater detail about the plans for the new prison including the proposed site layout, building design and appearance and how the area will be landscaped.
