### 3. Public Participation – Parish Council Meetings

Councillors are available to meet residents privately, to discuss matters of a confidential nature. All Parish Councillors have signed the Code of Conduct declaration, with regard to their personal and pecuniary interests in the village. ### 4. Planning Update

The appeal by Gladman Developments Ltd on the land north west of the Lodge of Burtonfields Hall has been withdrawn. This was to build 210 residential dwellings, including up to 25% affordable housing. 2 The Square, Stamford Bridge, the erection of a two storey building for a café/restaurant and a flat at first floor level, following demolition of existing building has been passed.

Natalie Venning (ERYC Digital Services Officer) came to update the Parish Councillors on phase two of superfast Broadband East Riding. Superfast broadband is now available in Stamford Bridge and residents are to contact their Internet service provider, to upgrade for faster speeds. ### 6. Parking

Following a meeting with one of ERYC's parking attendants, it has now been confirmed that attendants will be visiting Stamford Bridge three to four times per week, including weekends. They are also patrolling around the school parking area.

### 7. Buses

After complaints from residents about lack of paper timetables on buses, out-of-date timetables in the village, and old displays, Councillor Shuttleworth met with First and arranged new paper timetables put at each bus stop and there has been agreement that paper timetables - to include First and Transdev bus timetables - will be available to residents. She is liaising with ERYC over new display frames. The Parish Council is continuing to pay £2,000.00 to support the evening Transdev service. ## Community Engagement

The Parish Council has helped with three events this quarter. Square closure for the Backfire event at The New Inn, Seeing to traffic control being installed at the end of High Catton Road for the Yorkshire Marathon. They also oversaw the Remembrance Day parade and road closures. All these events have gone very well.

### 8. Projects Around The Village

The Parish council asked ERYC to provide bicycle racks at the football pitch at Reckondales and also at the Station Club. These will provide plenty of racks, where people can lock their bicycles thus encouraging people to cycle. This will also help with traffic congestion, especially on Sunday morning when there are too many cars parked on Low Catton Road for Reckondales Field.
